Golf Outings

Information Sheet

Consider Bradford Country Club as the site for your group's golf outing or annual tournament. Whether this is your first or tenth annual event, we at Bradford Country Club guarantee you, your employees and your guests will have a day that you will all long remember. We are pleased to provide you with a great golf experience, as well as an after golf lunch or dinner that all will enjoy. It is our objective to ensure your outing or special occasion exceeds your expectations.

Our Policies

1. Each tee time represents (4) four green fees (see "Fees" following)
2. Deposits: A \$5.00 per player deposit is required to secure your outing date. This deposit is non-refundable if your group cancels less than two weeks prior to your scheduled date. If a minimum of two weeks (ten business days) is given prior to canceling your event, a green fee credit will be issued for the advance deposit. No cash refunds will be given. Two weeks prior to your event, you will be asked to confirm the number of tee times you will using, along with the player name and desired pairings, if any. You will be charged for the number of confirmed tee times given; no refunds or credits will be issued for guest no-shows.
3. Golf Car Policy: All outings and functions scheduled to play on both weekdays or weekends must use our golf cars. Local restrictions and golf car safety procedures will be strictly enforced. Damage to golf cars caused by reckless driving will be the sole responsibility of the golf car operator, if not the organizer of the golf outing.
4. Dress Code: All players must wear appropriate golf attire. Tank-tops, tee-shirts and cut-off jeans are not permitted. Golf shoes or sneakers are required footwear to protect our greens. Bradford Country Club strongly encourages the use of spikeless or soft spiked golf shoes.
5. Food & Beverage: No person or group may bring food or beverage to Bradford Country Club. Coolers, beer cases and alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed. We will provide adequate refreshments at reasonable prices to you and your guests. Drinking water is provided at least every (4) four holes.

We have extensive catering services available to suit your group's needs. A menu can be arranged, and every group of (28) twenty-eight persons or more is required to guarantee one meal per person.

Two food service areas are available for use. Our golf pro and function coordinator will work together to determine which location in our facility is appropriate to hold your lunch or dinner. Additional food or beverage staff fees may be assessed for groups over 100.

An Outing Menu has been created that offers items ranging from \$10.00 - \$22.99 per person (plus 5% state tax, 7% administrative fee and 12% service fee) Hors d'oeuvres and other appetizers (along with their pricing), as well as a full bar are available upon request.

6. Shotgun Starts: To be eligible for a shotgun start, groups must have a minimum of (70) seventy players. We have a 144 player maximum per outing.
7. Special Requirements: All groups of (24) twenty-four or more must spend a minimum of \$8 per person in the Pro-Shop for prizes. Available items are gift certificates, towels, balls, clothing and other merchandise.

Custom Outing Services Available

The following custom services are available upon request to help enhance the success of your golf outing! Some services will be assessed additional fees per person. Our golf pro will work with your group to establish what services will work best for our outing..

1. Printed local rules of play.
2. "Within-the-Match" contests such as longest drive, closest to the pin, target green and accurate drive.
3. Assistance in selecting merchandise, printing trophies and providing gift certificates as prizes.
4. Assistance in establishing golf player handicaps for players who may not have one.
5. A tournament scoreboard, score sheets and scorecards
6. Tee prizes and/or special awards
7. Golf instructional clinics and "short course" matches on our putting green
8. On-Course beverage service
9. Locker and shower facilities

SPECIAL NOTE:

Throughout its long history, the game of golf has been recognized for the courteous etiquette of its players and the speed with which they play. Please make your players aware of the need to conduct themselves properly and to play prompt, ready golf.
